

WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY:

As we mark the 58th World Day of Social Communications on May 12th, Pope Francis urges us to cultivate wisdom of

He stated that "at this time in history, which risks becoming rich in technology and poor in humanity, our reflections must begin with the human heart...the inward place of our encounter with God."
