

The first Sunday of Advent is with us again, a curtain raiser, ushering in the new year of the Church. The season has a twofold character. It is a preparation for celebrating Christ's birth among us and a reminder of his second coming in glory, at the end of time. During the run—up to Christmas we can benefit from giving some consideration to who we are, what we are doing with our lives and how we are approaching the one great test that really matters, our personal meeting with the Lord on judgement day. During Advent the Church makes an appeal for an

improvement in our lives and for a new depth of sincerity to our religion. It calls on us to make a fresh start at building a closer relationship with Christ. Prayer, penance and works of mercy are necessary preparations for the coming of the Lord. It provides an opportunity to look around at what needs to be put right, to see how we have failed, and to assess the ways in which we can do better. Whatever our past, God is only too willing to look lovingly upon us. His arms are always outstretched to welcome us home. Advent is above all a time to deepen our friendship with God by thinking of his great love for us in sending his Son as our Saviour.

donations to help defray expenses and to all who purchased tickets. We couldn't have done it without you!




