THE MASS: STEP BY STEP

LITURGY OF THE WORD: The Profession of Faith or Creed appears in two forms in the new edition of the Roman Missal, the Nicene Creed and the Apostles' Creed and is recited at every Sunday Mass. The Apostles' Creed is normally recited during Lent and Easter as is it the creed used at Baptism which is usually celebrated during Easter. The Nicene Creed is generally used throughout the remainder of the year. The Creed has been recited during the Mass since the year 589 AD. Through it, week by week, generation after generation, the faith of the Church is handed on and unites Catholics in the one Faith that we all share.

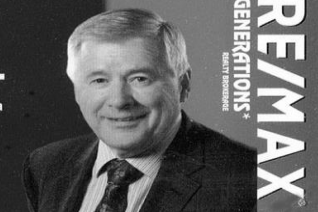

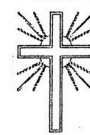
